The creation access (75 CHF) includes public access to workshop, access to mobile video devices exhibitions as well as individualized help to realize your own device. The payment in CHF will take place on the first day of the festival.

Below are listed and described the different devices that you will find in the creation workshop. Only one device per person will be feasible during the workshop. **The persons who want to make a device will have to acquire the required material for the realization before the workshop**. Please tick the box of the device you want to create (only one choice per registration)

<u>Device 1 (Mobile VJ):</u> The device 1 is composed of a nylon packsack for child with metal framework, of a 12 v battery (acid or lithium) with a maximum weight of 7 kilos, of a pure sinus converter 12 / 220 v (please check the watts power of your video projector and be sure your converter is enough powerful), of an adapted battery charger, of a support arm (articulated halogen arm is a wise and not expensive choice) and of a 1500 lumens minimum video projector with minimal space requirement and minimum contrast of 2000:1.

<u>Device 2 (Suitcase VJ)</u>: The device 2 is composed of a metal suitcase, of a battery 12 v (acid or lithium) with a maximum weight of 3,5 kilos, of a sinus pure converter 12 / 220 v (please check the watts power of your video projector and be sure your converter is enough powerful), of an adapted battery charger, of a multimedia player and of a a 1500 lumens minimum video projector with minimal space requirement and minimum contrast of 2000:1. A PC ventilator will be required too. We remind you that the whole of these components must be contained in the suitcase.

Device 3 (Caddy VJ): The device 3 is composed of a big area caddy or a stroller, of a battery 12 v (acid or lithium), of a pure sinus converter 12 / 220 v, of an adapted battery charger and of a 1500 lumens minimum video projector with minimal space requirement and minimum contrast of 2000:1. With this device, it is possible to use heavy long autonomy batteries and a relatively powerful and bulky video projector.

Generally speaking, the weight/power ratio is an important factor. The more your battery is powerful, the more it is heavy and the more it has an influence on your ability to carry the device. We advise you to choose lithium batteries or NICD rather than acid batteries. Lithium batteries are more expensive but they are lighter (especially for device 1 and 2). It's up to you to make a wise choice, considering these data. Batteries must always be waterproof.
